The Lord will wield from Zion † your scepter of **pów**er: \* rule in the midst of **áll** your <u>foes</u>.


A prince from the day of your birth † on the holy **móun**tains; \* from the womb before the dawn **Í** begot you.


# Reading Hebrews 10:12-14

He <u>has</u> shown the **stréngth** of <u>his</u> arm, \* he has scattered the proud **in** their conceit.


